24 AUG (Monday):

SAINT BARTHOLOMEW, Apostle

Bartholomew may have preached in Asia Minor and written a Gospel (now lost). He was martyred in Armenia.

25 AUG (Tuesday):

SAINT LOUIS IX of FRANCE, King and Patron (1226-1270)

Louis was devoted to his people and saw his kingly duties in light of his faith. He is the patron of the **Third Order of the Franciscans**.



SAINT JOSEPH CALASANZ, Priest (1556-1648)

27 AUG (Thursday):

SAINT MONICA, (322-387)

A Christian from birth, she was given in marriage to a bad-tempered, adulterous pagan named Patricius. She prayed constantly for the conversion of her husband (who converted on his death bed), and of her son, **St. Augustine** (who converted after a wild life and 18 years of his mother's prayers).



28 AUG (Friday):

SAINT AUGUSTINE, Bishop and Doctor of the Church (354-430)

Augustine was brought up in the Christian faith but did not receive baptism. An ambitious school-boy of brilliant talents and violent passions, he early lost both his faith and his innocence. He persisted in his irregular life and doctrinal errors until he was 32. Then one day, stung to the heart by the account of some sudden conversions, he cried out, "The unlearned rise and storm heaven, and we, with all our learning, for lack of courage lie inert!" His mother, **St. Monica**, had been praying unceasingly for **18 years** for Augustine's return to the faith. Augustine's *Confessions* are a triumph to read.



29 AUG (Saturday):

THE MARTYRDOM OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST

This great religious reformer was sent by God to prepare the people for the Messiah. His vocation was one of selfless giving. The only power he claimed was the Spirit of Yahweh. Scripture tells us that many people followed John, looking to him for hope. John never allowed himself the false honor of receiving these people for his own glory. He knew his calling was one of preparation.

NATIVITY SCHOOL OF RELIGION NEWS: 2015-2016

Registration has begun for **Nativity's Children's Faith Formation Program**. Children who attend public school in 1st through 8th grades should be enrolled in Nativity's School of Religion for ongoing faith formation.

Registration forms and information packets are available online at www.nativitymenlo.org under the **School of Religion** link. Classes begin on **Sunday, 13 September 2015**.

Mrs. Hickam will be available outside Church after the Masses on **23 August 2015 ~ 08:00, 09:30, and 11:30 AM**; and all Masses on **29-30 August 2015** to register your children and answer any questions about the program. Classes for grade levels 1-6 and the Sacraments Class are held on **Sundays from 08:15-09:15 AM** and continue on into the **09:30 AM** Mass with our Children's Liturgy of the Word. There is space for students at all grade levels 1-8 and high school students who have not yet received the Sacraments. Please come by the table or call/email the School of Religion office if you need any forms or have any questions or concerns.

Just a reminder: **First Reconciliation/First Communion** requires **2 years** of instruction before a child is eligible to receive these Sacraments. Children who attend public school should be enrolled in the School of Religion starting in Grade 1 and they are encouraged to continue onto the next grade level after they receive their First Communion, through the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

The School of Religion **Confirmation Preparation** program is also a **two-year** program as required by the Archdiocese of San Francisco. Children should be enrolled as soon as they enter the 7th grade, as well as those older students who have not yet been confirmed. Students who attend Catholic high schools that do not have a confirmation program should enroll in this class. Classes are held on **Wednesday** evenings, from **07:00-08:00 PM**. For more information, please go to the link on the parish website (www.nativitymenlo.org) or call/email the CCD office. Confirmation classes begin on **Wednesday, 14 October 2015**.

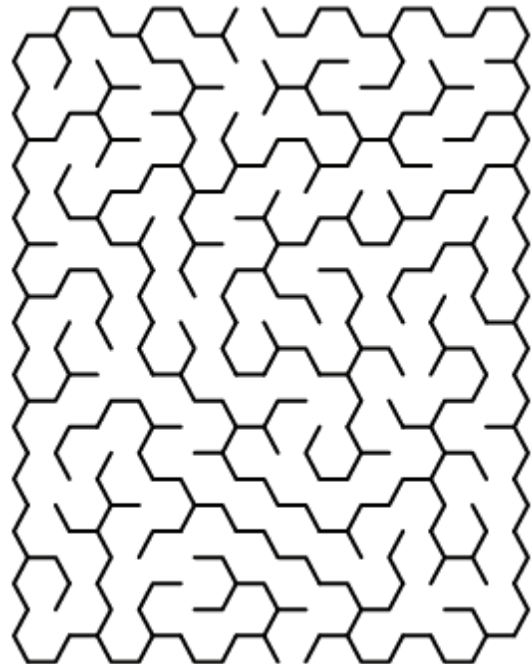
