11 APR (Monday): SAINT STANISLAUS, Bishop and Martyr (1030-1079)

Stanislaus was born to the Polish nobility. When his parents died, he distributed his inheritance to the poor. He became (reluctantly) bishop of Cracow in 1072. He was known for his preaching against sinful living, regardless of the sinner's class. Stanislaus was killed by King Boleslaus the Cruel after Stanislaus ex-communicated him due to his war crimes and attempted theft of land from the Church; Stanislaus was murdered while celebrating Mass. Reaction against Boleslaus was so great that he fled the country, never to return; his guilt led him to become a monk. Stanislaus became a symbol of Polish patriotism and nationalism.

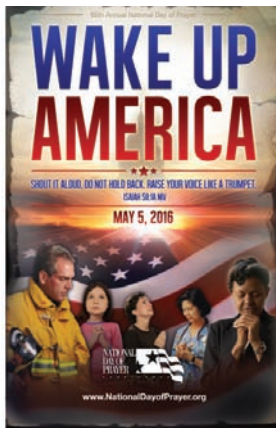

MOTHER MARY ANGELICA OF THE ANNUNCIATION

20 APRIL 1923 ~ 27 MARCH 2016

Mother Mary Angelica of the Annunciation, a Poor Clare, has been widely credited for having changed both Catholic media and the face of Catholicism in the United States. She passed away on March 27 (Easter Sunday) after a lengthy struggle with the after-effects of a stroke. She was 92 years old.

Mother Angelica launched **Eternal Word Television Network** (EWTN) in 1981. Today it transmits 24-hour-a-day programming to more than 264 million homes in 144 countries. What began with approximately 20 employees has now grown to nearly 400. The religious network broadcasts terrestrial and shortwave radio around the world, operates a religious goods catalog and publishes the National Catholic Register and Catholic News Agency, among other publishing ventures. It is the largest religious network in the world. (In March 1978, during a seven-day visit to Chicago, Mother visited a Baptist-run television station. When Mother saw how many people could be reached by the cameras, video equipment and a few people operating out of a tiny television studio, she walked out and famously exclaimed: "Lord, I gotta have one of these!")

In addition to EWTN, Mother also founded the **Our Lady of the Angels Monastery**, the **Franciscan Missionaries of the Eternal Word**, the **Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament**, and the **Knights of the Holy Eucharist**.
