# SAINTS AND OBSERVANCES

SOLEMNITY, FEAST, MEMORIAL • OPTIONAL MEMORIAL • OTHER

**12 NOV (Monday)**

**VETERANS DAY**

**SAINT JOSAPHAT, Bishop and Martyr (1580-1623)**

**13 NOV (Tuesday):**

**SAINT FRANCES XAVIER CABRINI (1850-1917)**

Foundress of the *Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart*. Frances and six Sisters arrived in New York from Italy in 1889. They worked among immigrants, especially Italians. **Mother Cabrini** founded 67 institutions, including schools, hospitals, and orphanages in the United States, Europe and South America.

**14 NOV (Wednesday):**

**SAINT NICHOLAS TAVELIC AND COMPANIONS, Martyrs (d. 1391)**

As Franciscan custodians of the shrines in the Holy Land, **Nicholas, Deodat, Peter of Narbonne** and **Stephen of Cuneo** decided to attempt direct conversion of the Muslims. Reading from a prepared statement before the Qadi (Muslim official), they said that all people must accept the gospel of Jesus. When they were ordered to retract their statement, they refused. After beatings and imprisonment, they were beheaded before a large crowd.

**16 NOV (Friday):**

**SAINT MARGARET OF SCOTLAND (~1045-1093)**

Granddaughter of King Edmund Ironside of England; great-niece of Saint Stephen of Hungary; Queen of Scotland. Margaret founded abbeys and used her position to work for justice and improved conditions for the poor.

**SAINT GERTRUDE, Religious (1256-1302)**

Gertrude, a Benedictine nun, received visions of Jesus and mystical instruction, which formed the basis of her writings. She helped spread devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

**17 NOV (Saturday)**

**SAINT ELIZABETH OF HUNGARY (1207-1231)**

The daughter of King Andrew of Hungary; she married Prince Louis of Thuringa at age 13. Built a hospital at the foot of the mountain on which her castle stood and tended to the sick herself. Once when she was taking food to the poor and sick, Prince Louis stopped her and looked under her mantle to see what she was carrying; the food had been miraculously changed to roses.

# Young Believers

## THE WIDOW'S "MITE"

In today's gospel we hear about the widow who placed two small coins into the temple treasury. These coins were likely bronze "*lepta*" or "*prutot*" of **Alexander Jan-naeus**, the Hasmonean King of Judaea from 103 to 76 B.C. Although these coins were minted long before Christ's lifetime, they were still in circulation during the first century A.D. Because the *lepton* and *prutah* were the lowest denomination coins that circulated in Jerusalem during Christ's lifetime, they are believed to be the coins referred to in the Biblical story of the poor widow. The *lepton* is the very smallest denomination and is probably the true "widow's mite." In fact, the *lepton* is probably the lowest denomination coin ever struck by any nation in all of history! *Lepta* and *prutot* were carelessly and crudely struck, usually off center and on small flans.
